## ***Subject: VATSIM-Radar Extend Position Feature***

---

**PURPOSE:** This bulletin provides guidance on VATSIM-Radar's new Extend Position feature.

**BACKGROUND:** VATSIM-Radar has implemented a capability that allows a controller working an approach position configured in the app to extend their current approach area to include additional areas.

**PROCEDURE:** A Potomac controller working multiple areas combined with their logged-in position (except when operating PCT Combined with no modifications) may list each area they control in the Controller Information section in CRC. The following options are available:

- MTV
- SHD
- CHP
- JRV

**EXAMPLE:** A Potomac controller working PACMAN (SHD, CHP, JRV) will, by default, display on VATSIM-Radar as SHD only. To extend the position to include CHP and JRV, add the following text to your Controller Information field in CRC:

- SHD,CHP,JRV

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** This feature works from any position within the Potomac TRACON and Washington Center. At the start of every control session, ensure the correct areas are set before activating. These can be added or removed during your session without disconnecting and reconnecting; however, proper configuration before activation will help avoid pilot confusion.
